Admission at the Cambridge Wing

Cambridge academic year starts in **September** and ends in **June**. For admission, an Admission Test (English, Math, Science) is conducted whose contents and sample paper can be downloaded from www.pisqdoha.com. After the entry test is passed, following documents are required (to be uploaded & submitted in hard copy form) to complete the admission process.

1. FOUR id card size pictures (of the candidate)
2. Result Card/Report Card of the previous class annual exam (original)
3. School Leaving Certificate – SLC (original)
4. Character Certificate (original)
5. Copy of the Health card (of the candidate)
6. Copies of Passport (of the candidate and his/her parents)
7. Copies of Qatar Residential Permit (of the candidate and his/her parents)
8. Copy of Qatar blue plate (residential address plate)
9. Employment Letter of the parent/guardian

Cambridge Wing Academic Year and Exam Plan

Key Stage 3: Year-8, IG Prep (VIII)

This is the level where students will begin studying Cambridge International curriculum for all subjects. They will study **4** compulsory subjects and **3** subjects of their chosen group. The study plan will follow Cambridge syllabi and paper pattern. Students will be assessed internally at the end of the year. [NOTE: *Qatar History* will also be taught through this year as a compulsory subject.]

Year begins: End of August

1st mid-term exam: End of October (internally assessed)

1st end-of-Term exam: December (internally assessed)

2nd mid-term exam: Mid of March (internally assessed)

Final exam: June (internally assessed)

Key Stage 3: Year-9, IG-I (IX)

The students will continue studying Cambridge International curriculum for all subjects (including *Qatar History*). The study plan will follow Cambridge syllabi and paper pattern. Students will be assessed internally at the end of the year.

Year begins: End of August

1st mid-term exam: End of October (internally assessed)

1st end-of-Term exam: December (internally assessed)

2nd mid-term exam: Mid of March (internally assessed)

Final exam: June (internally assessed)

Key Stage 4: Year-10, IG-II (X)

The students of Year 10 will continue studying Cambridge international curriculum for all subjects. The study plan will follow Cambridge syllabi and paper pattern. At the end of the year, students will sit in Cambridge Assessment International Education (CAIE) examination for three subjects: **English (0510)**, **Islamiyat (0493)**, and **Global Perspectives (0457)**.

Year begins: End of August

1st mid-term exam: End of October (internally assessed)

1st end-of-Term exam: December (internally assessed)

1st Mock exam: Start of March (internally assessed)

2nd Mock exam: Mid of April (internally assessed)

Final exam: May-June (externally assessed by CAIE for English, Islamiyat, Global Perspectives)

Key Stage 4: Year-11, IG-III (XI)

The students of Year 11 will continue studying Cambridge's international curriculum for subjects other than English, Islamiyat, and Global Perspectives. The study plan will follow Cambridge syllabi and paper pattern. At the end of the year, students will sit in Cambridge Assessment International Education (CAIE) examination for four subjects.

Year begins: End of August

1st mid-term exam: End of October (internally assessed)

1st end-of-Term exam: December (internally assessed)

1st Mock exam: Start of March (internally assessed)

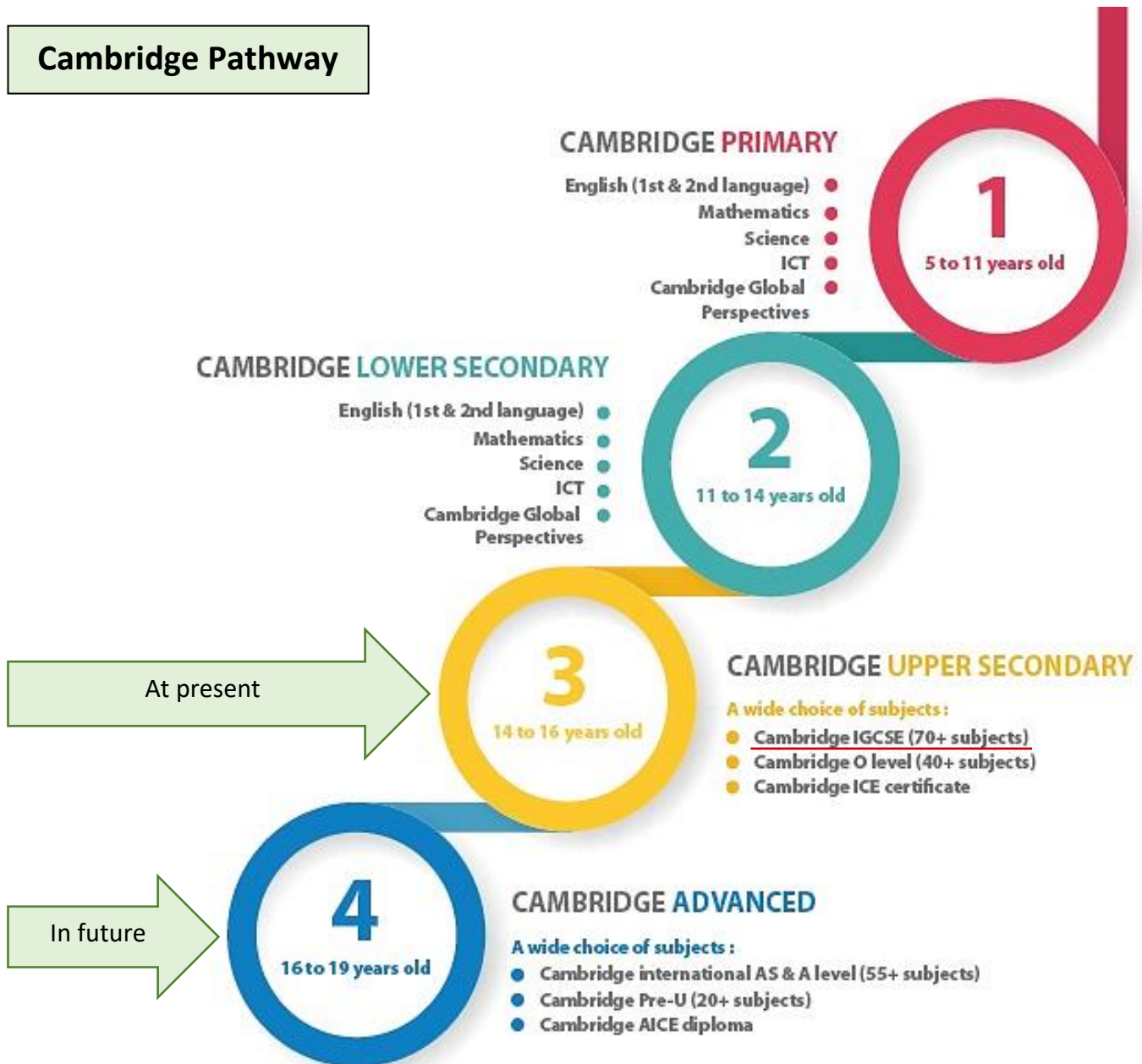
2nd Mock exam: Mid of April (internally assessed)

Final exam: May-June (externally assessed by CAIE)

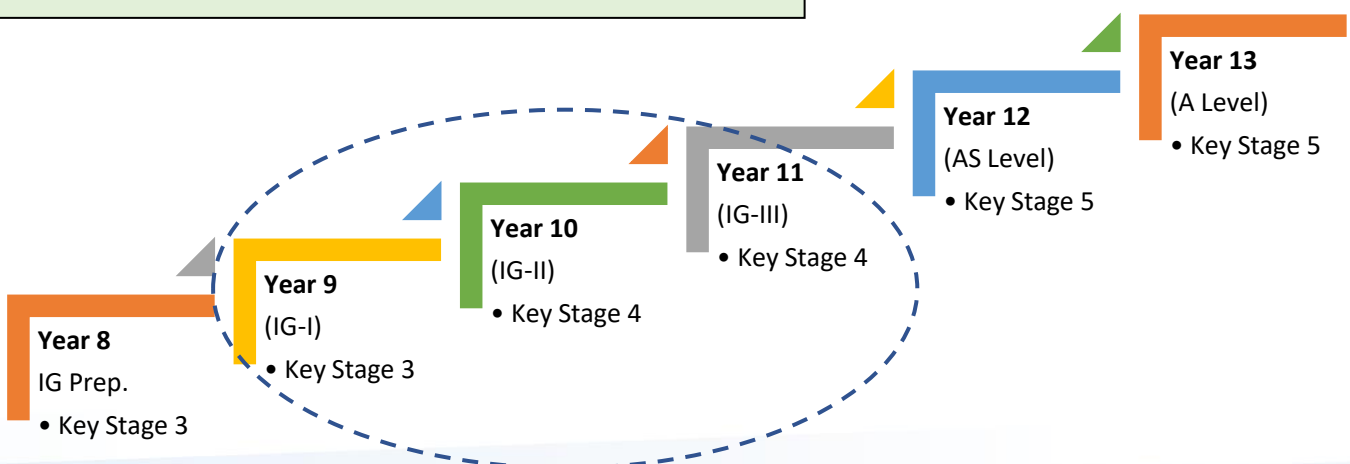
Key Stage 5: Cambridge AS (Year-12) and A2 Level (Years-13)

Cambridge IGCSE Class Progression at PISQ

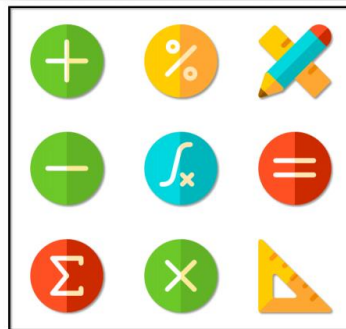


Talent Clubs

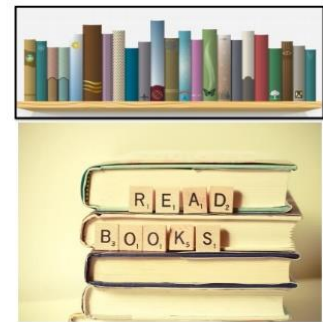
